

LCISD 2022-2023 COVID POLICY

As we prepare for the 2022-2023 school year, Lamar CISD looks forward to welcoming our students back to campus. The district continues to work in partnership with local and state health officials to monitor the spread of viruses in the community.

Lamar CISD is committed to creating a safe learning environment for our students and staff. To ensure safe in-person learning experiences, the following COVID-19 protocols will be in place in District facilities for the 2022-2023 school year.

Disease Mitigation Protocols

Face Covering Protocols

Face coverings are optional. Parents are best equipped to decide whether their child should wear a mask.

The district will support any student or staff member who chooses to wear a face covering.

Screening Protocols

Parents/guardians are recommended to screen their students each day prior to sending their student to school:

- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- New Loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Significant muscle pain or ache
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting

*If your student is exhibiting one or more of these symptoms outside your child's norm, the student should be evaluated by their medical provider and not return to school. Nurses will continuously monitor the screening process and follow up with the parent/guardian on the health status of the students.
