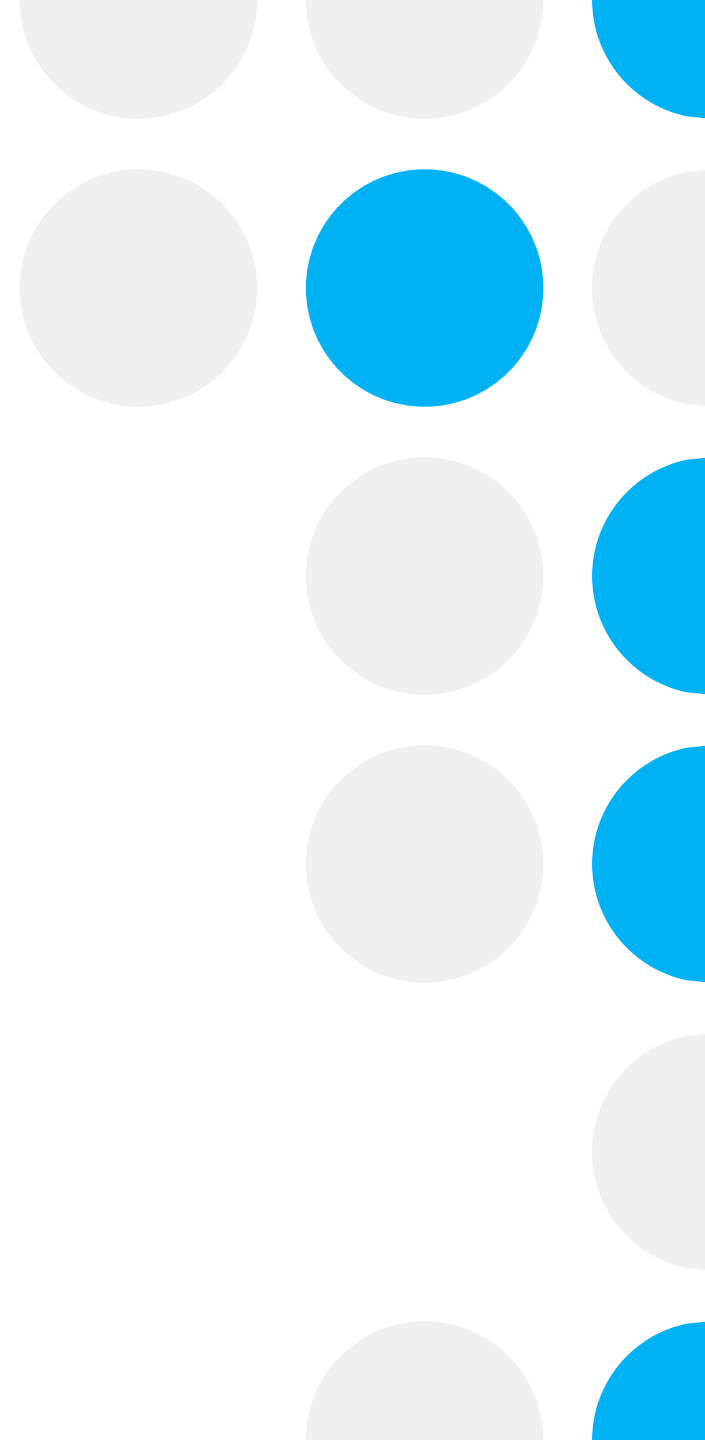

## **UIL Legacy Provision Application Process**

---

# Legacy Provision Eligibility

- Students rezoned to Terry, Foster, or Tomas for 2024-25 may remain through graduation if the student meets the extracurricular achievement participation exemption
    - UIL Academics
    - UIL Athletics
    - UIL Performing Arts
  - A legacy student must provide their own transportation
  - Siblings are not eligible for Legacy Provision Exemptions

# UIL Academics

- Student has participated in an event or on a team that advanced to regional competition or beyond and has approval of the Advanced Academics Director

- Business skills contests include Accounting
  - Essay contests include the Barbara Jordan Historical Essay Competition and Latino History Essay Competition
  - Journalism contests include Copy Editing, Editorial Writing, Headline Writing, Feature Writing and News Writing
  - Language Arts contests include Literary Criticism, Ready Writing and Spelling and Vocabulary
  - Social Studies competitions include Current Issues & Events, and Social Studies
  - Speech & Debate contests include Congress, Cross Examination Debate, Lincoln Douglas Debate, Informative Speaking, Persuasive Speaking, Prose Interpretation and Poetry Interpretation.
  - STEM contests include Calculator Applications, Computer Science, Mathematics, Number Sense, Robotics and Science
  - Theatre contests include Filmmaking, One-Act Play and Theatrical Design

# UIL Athletics – Team Sports

- Earned a varsity letter by playing in 75% of games or play in a playoff game and have Executive Athletics Director or Athletic Director Approval

# UIL Athletics – Individual Sports

- Competed in the varsity district tournament for 2024-25 for their representative school, earned a varsity letter, and have Executive Director of Athletics or Athletic Director Approval
  - Individual Sports
    - Cross Country
    - Tennis
    - Golf
    - Wrestling
    - Track and Field
    - Swimming and Diving

# UIL Performing and Visual Arts

- Earned a varsity letter by earning at least 6 points per the band lettering guidelines in the Secondary Student Handbook (page 126-138) and have approval of the PVA Director.
  - Performing Arts
    - Band
    - Color Guard
    - Choir
    - Orchestra

# Performing and Visual Arts

- Earned a Varsity letter by earning at least 40 Thespian points per the Secondary Student Handbook (page 138) and have approval of the PVA Director.
  - Theater
-

# Legacy Provision can be revoked if:

- The student fails to maintain satisfactory behavior, attendance, and/or academic performance.
  - The student's parent or guardian provides false and/or misleading information to district officials.
  - The requested campus is closed to transfers due to insufficient room, facilities, and/or instructional staff.
  - Any other situation that the Superintendent deems may affect the safety or security of students and/or present a potential financial hardship to the district.

  - March 14, 2025
    - Approval/Denial of applications will be completed and submitted to the parent through email. Application must be completed by the parent with a parent email.
