




Circle Time/ Whole Group

Centers/ Work Rotations






Water Bottles

Please send a water bottle with your child each day. Having a water bottle allows for a quick drink and staying hydrated is important for learning ©. Water bottles will be sent home daily.


Please send spillproof water bottles. Pop top or straw water bottles are best.

Snack and Lunch

- Please do not send snacks that are messy and sticky. We don't like bugs and sticky attracts bugs.




Communication


Discipline Management

- Our discipline management system is "fill your bucket". We will be starting this in the next few weeks. It is a visual to help your child want to do their best and help others do their best. It is based on the book titled How Full is Your Bucket. Based on how full their buckets are at the end of each week, they are rewarded with a treat.
- We will use the green, yellow, red color system to monitor behavior. If they are on green at the end of the school day, they will receive a happy face in their folder. For the first 9 weeks, 3 happy faces per week earns a trip to the treasure box. The second 9 weeks, 4 happy faces will be needed, and the 3rd and 4th 9 weeks will need 5 happy faces to earn treasure box.
- We will be earning points to help our schoolwide houses earn points towards fun activities as well.
- If a child needs to take a break from an activity, we have a calm down location. This is meant to be a place where the child can regroup before rejoining the activity. They can self place themselves.
- We will note behavior on the daily report as well for ECSE students and I will email if I need to communicate with a Pegasus parent. If we feel a parent discussion is needed, we will contact you. As always, you can always contact me as well.





Paraprofessional




