

# Transportation

## Arrival

- Doors open at 7 am for car riders, yet we strongly encourage arrivals between 7:10 and 7:25. Students are tardy at 7:30.
- Separate entrances will be used for car riders, bus riders, walkers, and daycare.
- Students will go straight to the classroom upon arrival rather than assembling in the gym.
- Staff will be available each day to walk younger students to class and to assist older students with reaching their classrooms.
- Younger students should wear their color-coded, teacher buttons each day to assist staff in helping them to their classrooms.
- Students will wear face coverings during arrival and dismissal.
- Parents are not allowed to walk students to classrooms.
- Safety patrol will not be used the first semester. Parents should familiarize their students with unbuckling their seatbelts and exiting cars independently.

## Dismissal

- Separate entrances will be used for car riders, bus riders, walkers, and daycares.
- Staggered dismissal will be utilized to manage student movement in the building and decrease the risk of crowding at dismissal.
- All students will wear face coverings during dismissal.
- Safety patrol will not be used the first semester. Parents should familiarize their students with opening car doors, entering vehicles, and buckling their seatbelts independently.
- Sibling connections will be done outside the building.

## Transportation

- All students will wear face coverings on the bus, regardless of grade level.
- Students will wear their Smart Tags for dismissal, and parents are encouraged to use this resource to track bus arrival.
- No more than two students will be allowed per bus seat.
- Students will receive assigned seating on the bus.
- There will be a designated seat in the front for any student who is feeling ill.
- When possible, bus windows will be opened to allow outside air to circulate in the bus.
- Buses will be thoroughly cleaned regularly focusing on high-touch surfaces.
