DICKINSON Collared shirts (polo style, no logo) must be solid color navy blue, light blue, red, or white. Dickinson school shirts may be worn any day of the week. Bottoms, including leggings, must be solid khaki, navy blue or black pants, capris, shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers. Leggings may be worn under shorts or skirts, but not by themselves. Jeans are permitted on Fridays.

---students will be able to wear school shirts or collared shirts with uniform pants. Jeans can be worn on Fridays. Solid color (Khaki, navy blue or black) leggings only.

Students are required to wear collared shirts, specifically polo style with no logo, in solid colors such as navy blue, light blue, red, or white. Dickinson school shirts are allowed to be worn any day of the week. As for bottoms, students must wear solid khaki, navy blue, or black pants, capris, shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers. Leggings are permitted to be worn under shorts or skirts, but not on their own. On Fridays, students are allowed to wear jeans with no holes.

School Dress Code Guidelines

- Collared Shirts:
 - o Must be polo style with no logo
 - o Acceptable colors: navy blue, light blue, red, or white
 - o Dickinson school shirts may be worn any day of the week
- Bottoms:
 - o Must be solid khaki, navy blue, or black
 - o Acceptable options: pants, capris, shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers

- o Leggings may be worn under shorts or skirts, but not by themselves
- o Blue denim jeans are permitted on Fridays
