Parent has access to grades within Skyward just like all other courses

## Lone Star College Gradebook

Parent does NOT have access to LSC gradebook

## What if my child is failing?

DC teachers submit names of all students failing to DC counselor one week prior to official drop date. DC counselor meets with each student and reminds them of the drop date. Drop with a "W" and does not have a negative impact.
