Integrated Planning & Decision Making

The Council shall serve exclusively in an advisory role. BQA(Local) and BQA(Legal)

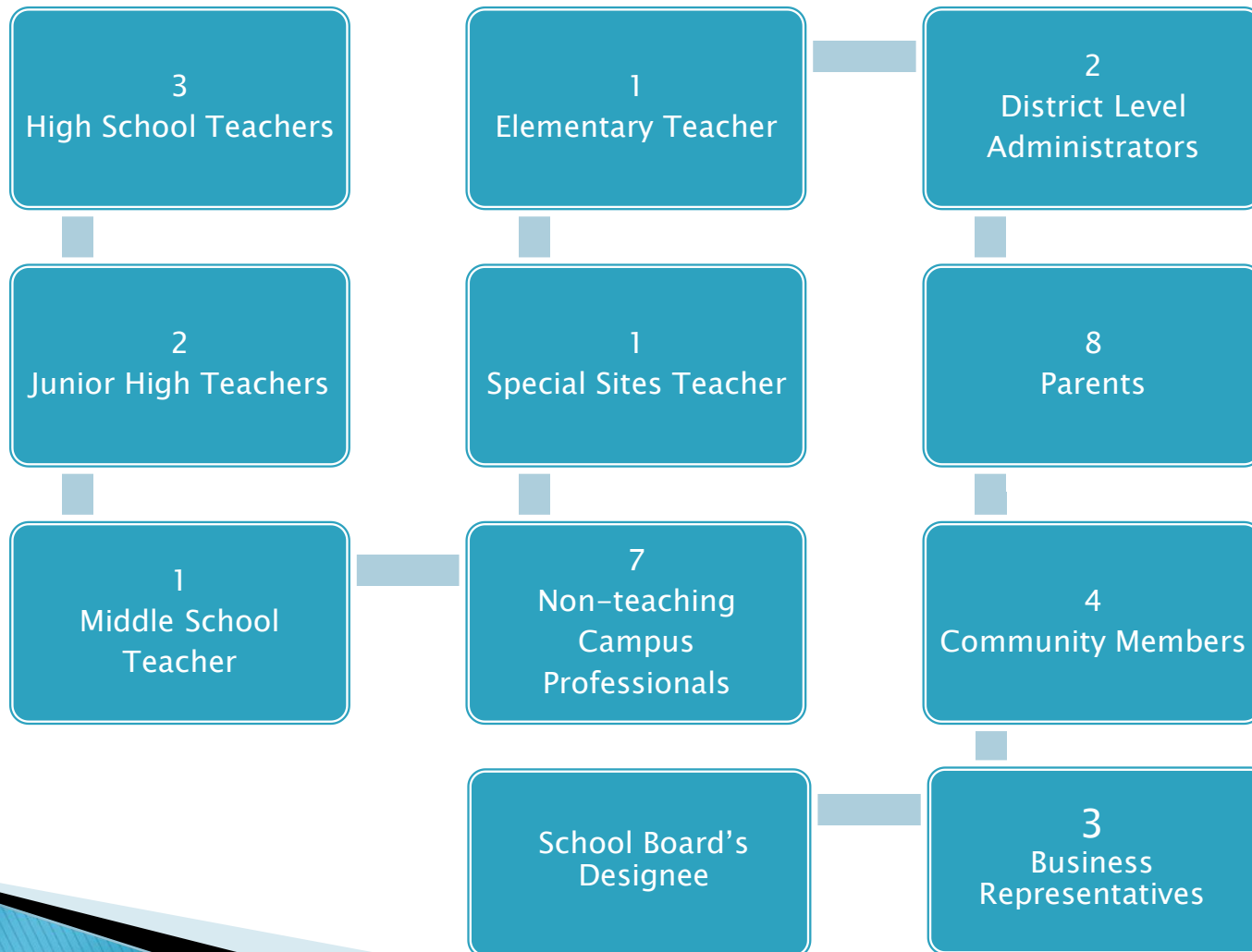
What is DSIC?

- 2/3 of committee must be classroom teachers


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


What is DSIC?

- Elected chairperson presiding
 - Agenda shared in advance

 - Elected secretary to take minutes to be posted following the meeting
