Participation

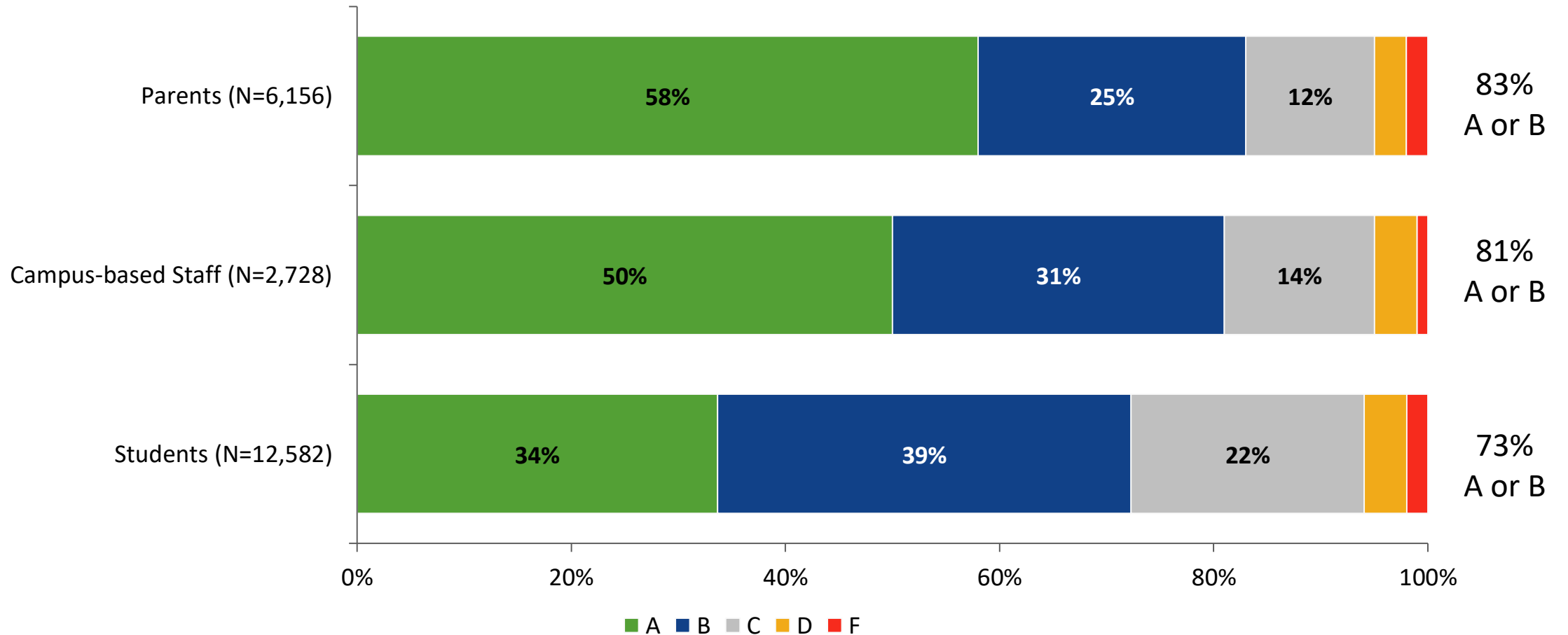
A total of **21,467** stakeholders joined the conversation on campus climate and quality in 2020-2021.

2017-2018: 20,744 participants

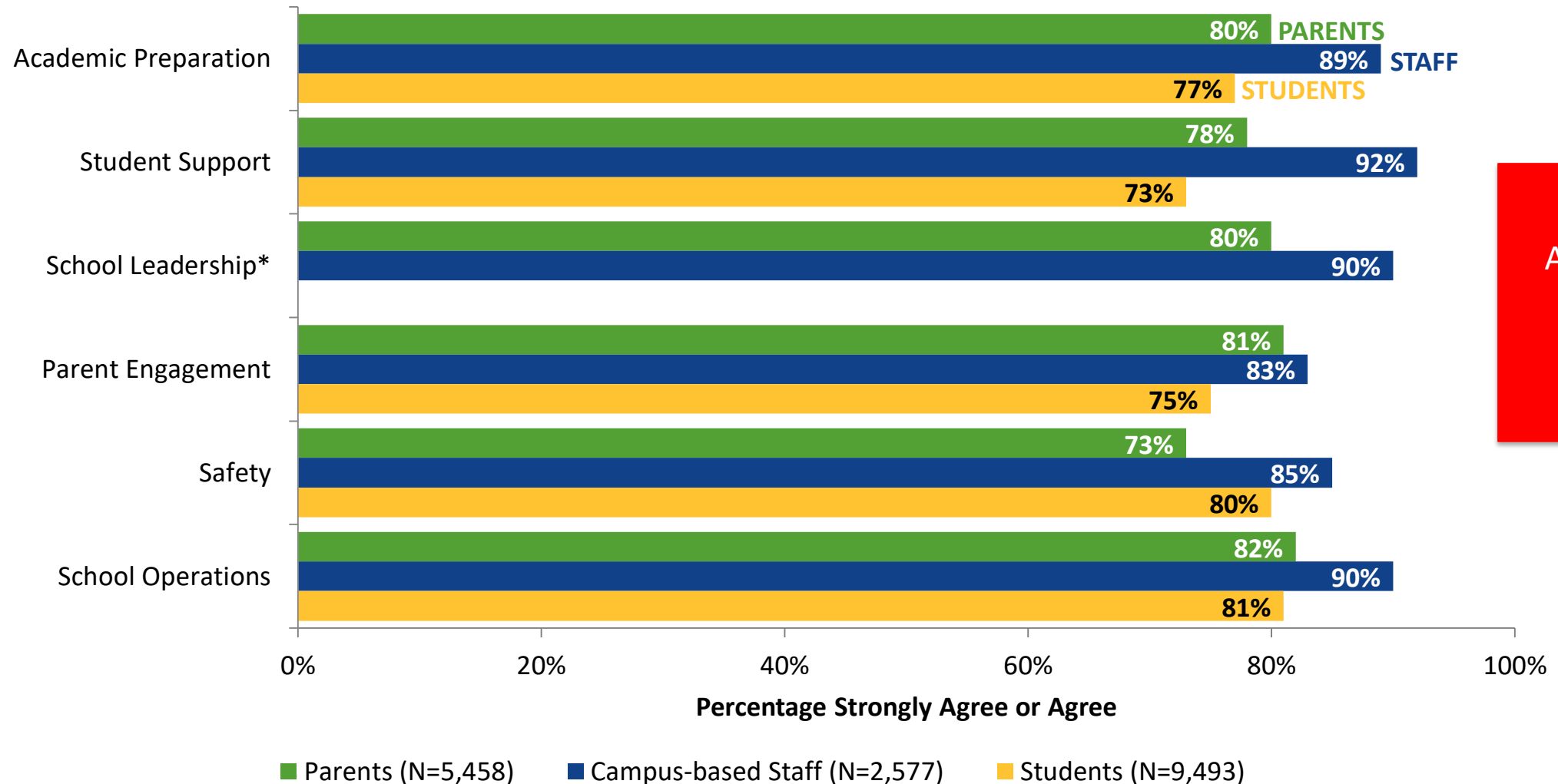
Overall Quality by Participant Group

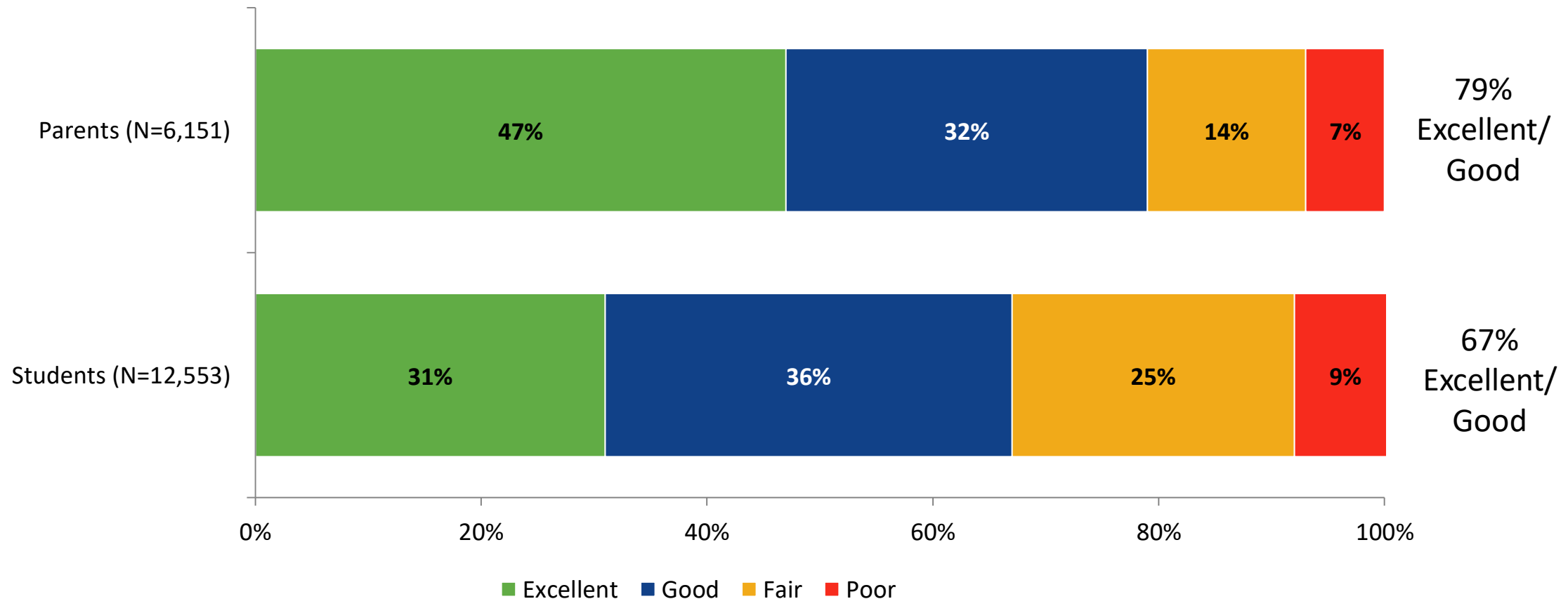

Overall COVID-19 Pandemic Response: Comparison by Participant Group

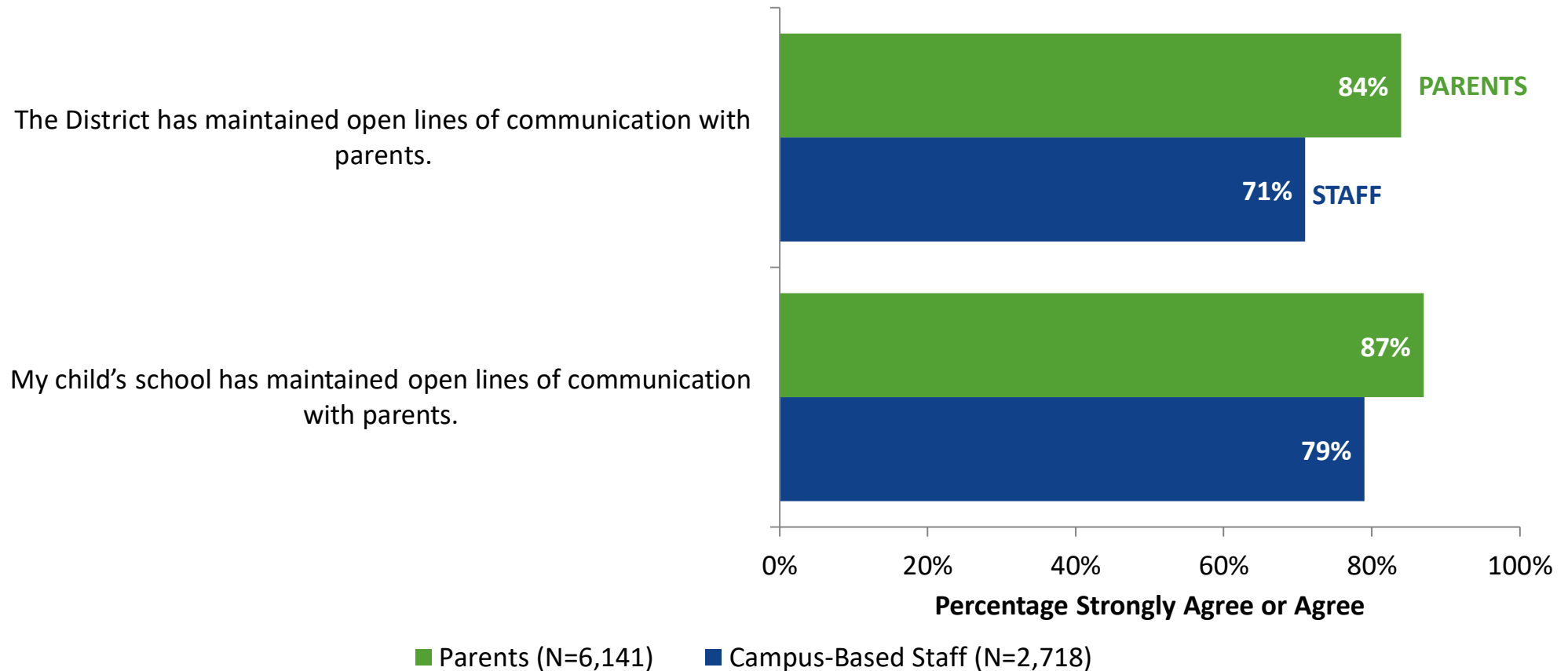
Overall, how would you rate how Lamar CISD handled the COVID-19 pandemic for the 2020-2021 school year?

How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statements?



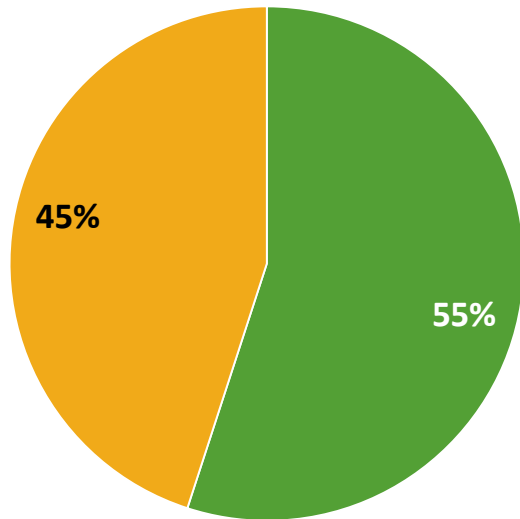

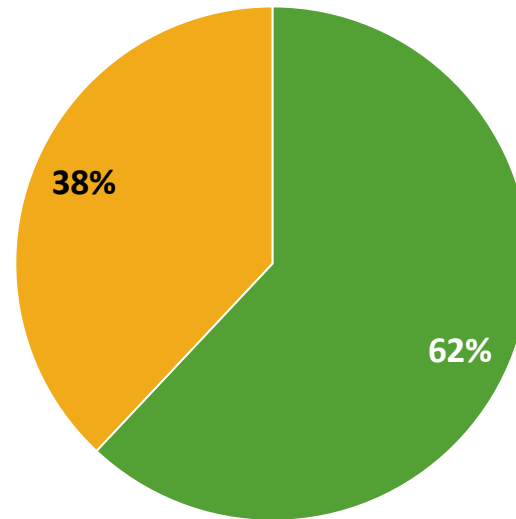
Has your child participated in virtual learning during the 2020-2021 school year? (N=6,147)

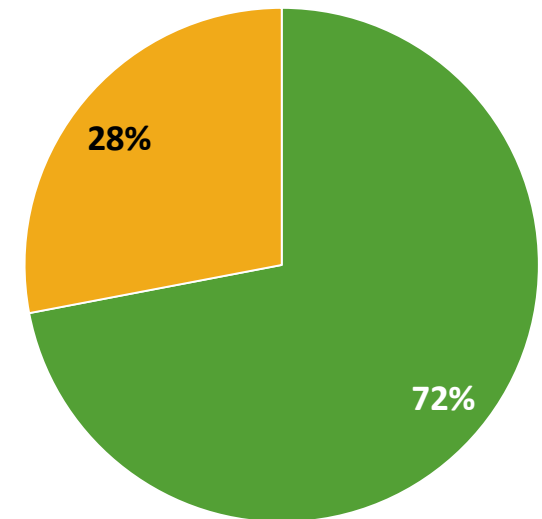
Have you participated in virtual learning during the 2020-2021 school year? (N=12,461)

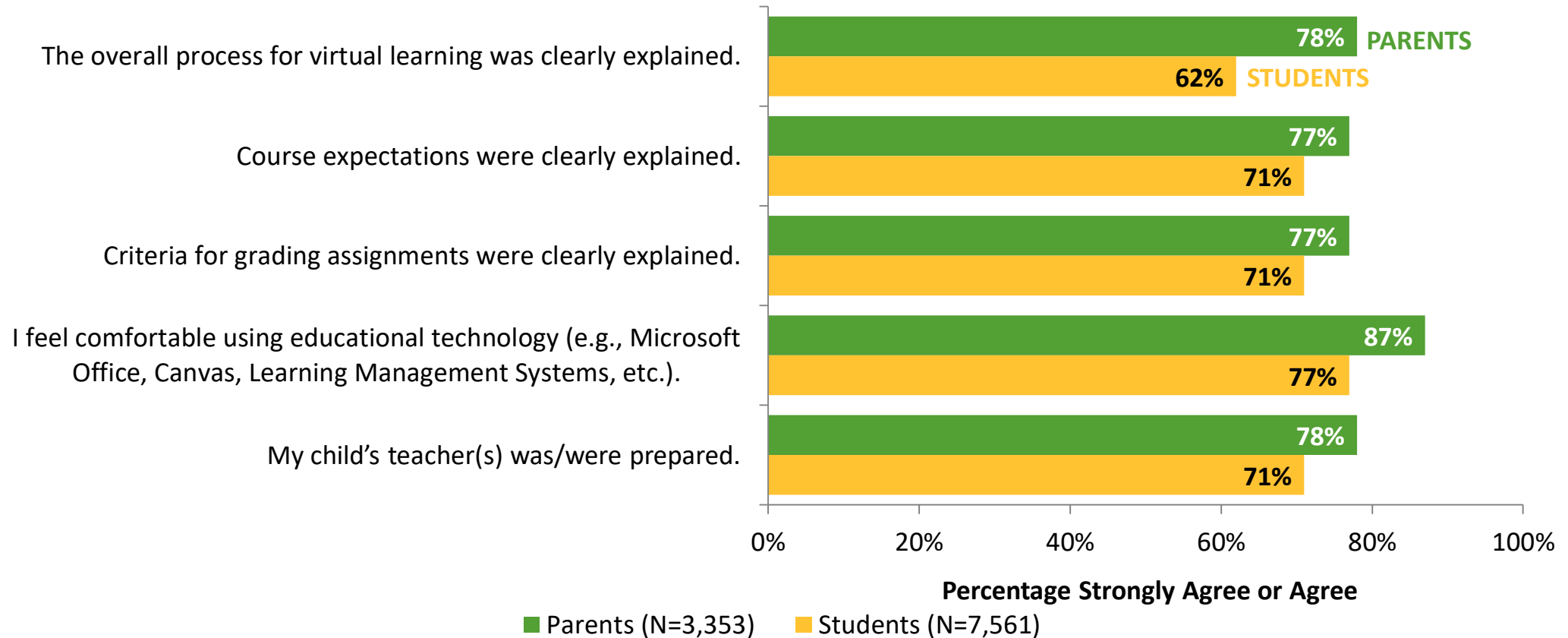

How strongly do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements?

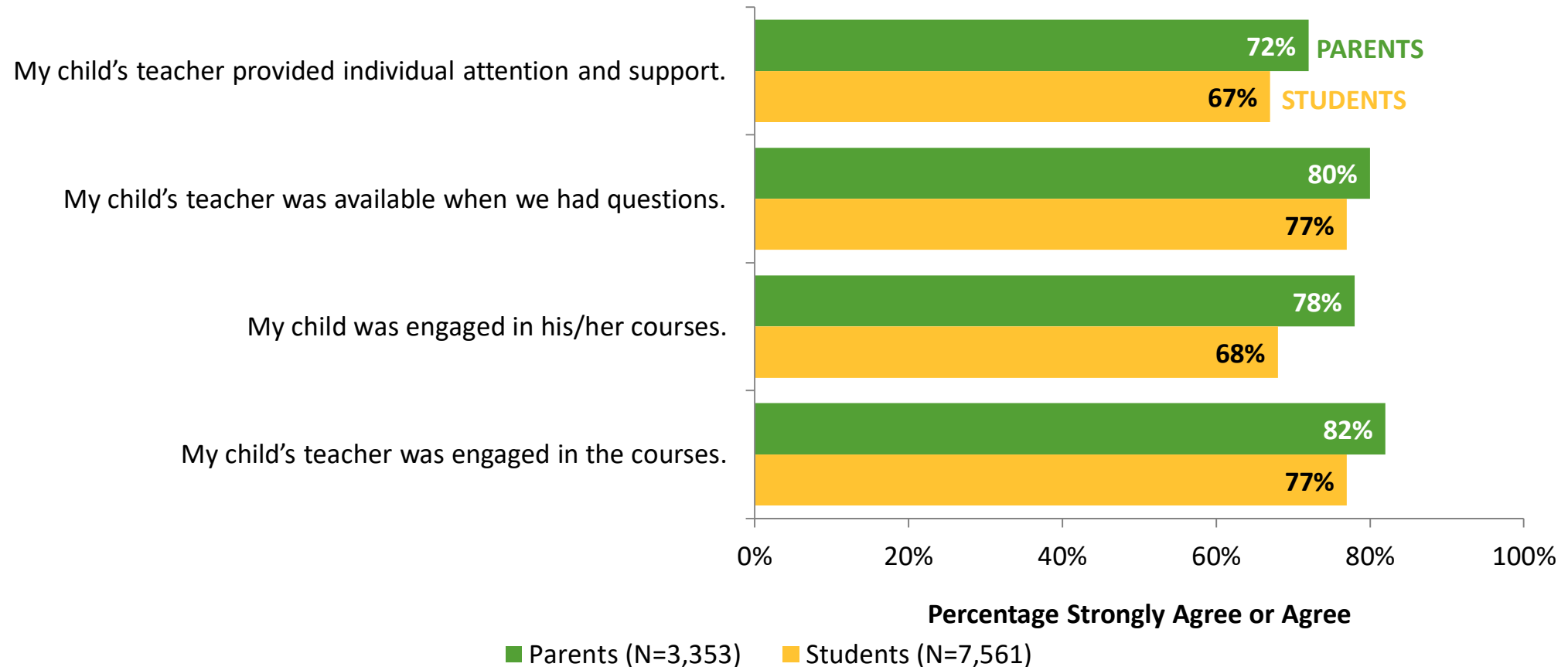

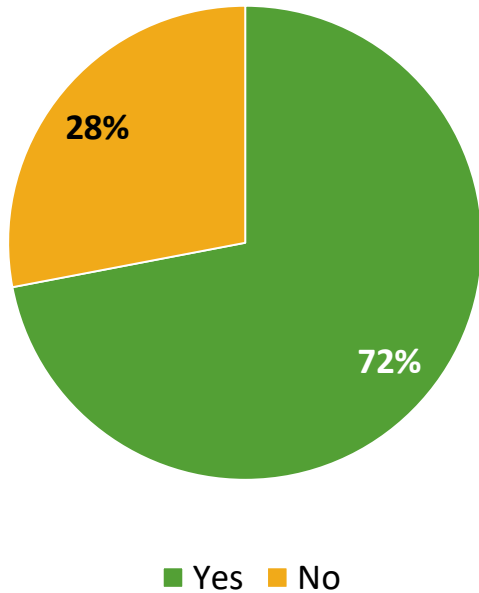

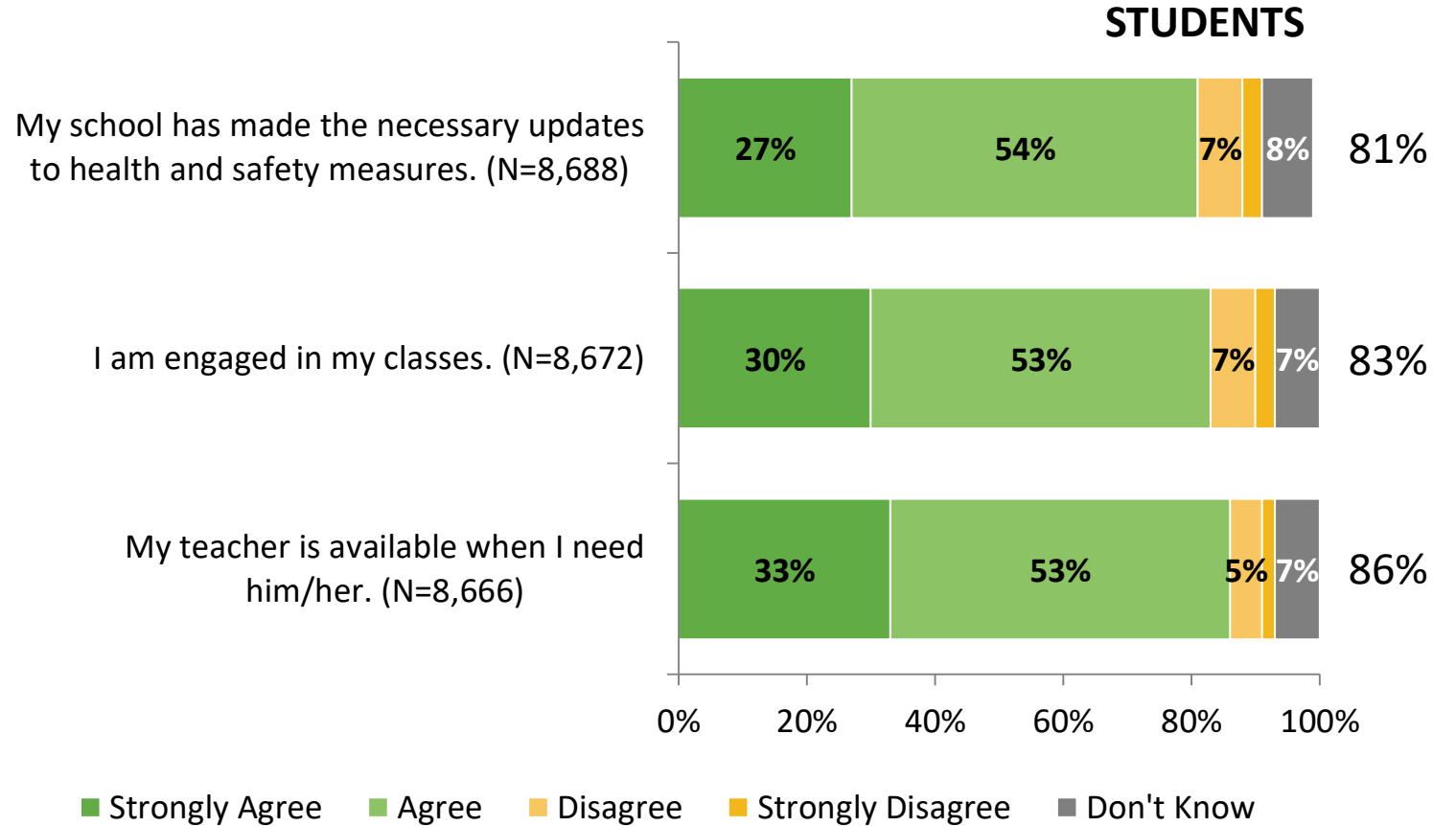
