<b>Lesson Topics</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Introduction</li> <li>2. Hook- "What is your favorite hobby? Teacher shares hobbies.</li> <li>3. Define hobby/examples of hobbies are shown (PowerPoint).</li> <li>4. "I'm going to give you one minute to discuss your favorite hobbies."</li> <li>5. Define a job (see PowerPoint).</li> <li>6. Define a career (see PowerPoint).</li> <li>7. "What do you want to be when you grow up? I'm going to give you one minute to discuss the top two careers you are interested in."</li> <li>8. Transition to goal setting. Define goals, short-term, intermediate, and long-term goals. (See PowerPoint)</li> <li>6. Provide examples of a short-term goal and a long-term goal.</li> <li>7. Give students an opportunity to classify some examples. For example, saving money to buy a new video game is a short-term goal.</li> <li>7. "I will give you one minute to share about a time you set a goal to save money to get something you really wanted."</li> <li>8. Explain why we set goals and the importance.</li> <li>9. Summary of the lesson. (See PowerPoint)</li> <li>10. Closing. "This video along with additional information and handouts can be found in Canvas."</li> </ol>
