Lesson Topics	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Introduction 2. Hook- "What is your favorite hobby? Teacher shares hobbies. 3. Define hobby/examples of hobbies are shown (PowerPoint). 4. "I'm going to give you one minute to discuss your favorite hobbies." 5. Define a job (see PowerPoint). 6. Define a career (see PowerPoint). 7. "What do you want to be when you grow up? I'm going to give you one minute to discuss the top two careers you are interested in." 8. Transition to goal setting. Define goals, short-term, intermediate, and long-term goals. (See PowerPoint) 6. Provide examples of a short-term goal and a long-term goal. 7. Give students an opportunity to classify some examples. For example, saving money to buy a new video game is a short-term goal. 7. "I will give you one minute to share about a time you set a goal to save money to get something you really wanted." 8. Explain why we set goals and the importance. 9. Summary of the lesson. (See PowerPoint) 10. Closing. "This video along with additional information and handouts can be found in Canvas."
